Instituted in the name of Late Anurag Gupta, an Indian Institute of Management (Ahmedabad) alumnus and an avid photographer, the festival aimed to recognize and promote the talents of our young, amateur photographers across all neuro-diversities. This is being done by offering free entry to participate in competitions and providing an international platform for them to showcase their work. This inclusive platform will hopefully open the door to new opportunities.

The goal of this photography exposition was to challenge, both neurotypical as well as neuro diverse young photographers, to capture architectural wonders. The photographs of these uniquely gifted young photographers were displayed online at 3-D virtual art exhibition from Feb 15 to March 6, 2021. These galleries were rented from a company in the Asia Pacific region.

Organized by The Art Sanctuary, this is one of its kind of festival. It has opened the floor for adult students with intellectual disabilities to participate and compete along with neurotypical young adults in the photography space.



The much-awaited Award Night - February 15th - Top 3 Winners were announced in each category of The Anurag Gupta Memorial Photography Exposition.


The first prize is of Rs 25,000, the second prize is of Rs 10,000 and the third prize is of Rs 5000. These prizes will be given to winners from both categories separately.


